

GOLD COAST OPEN HOUSE

- The City of Gold Coast joined the world-wide family of Open House events in 2015.
- Gold Coast Open House returns in 2020 for its sixth year on October 17 and 18.
- Gold Coast Open House is a registered charity, not-for-profit and run by a volunteer committee.
- A new Gold Coast Open House website goes live on Saturday October 17 at www.goldcoastopenhouse.com.au
- A program of armchair video tours, photo gallery and short films about significant Gold Coast buildings, spaces and places – old and new – is scheduled to play out online over Saturday and Sunday.
- Events are free but some must be booked. Bookings are open at www.goldcoastopenhouse.com.au
- The Focus on Architecture photography competition is held in conjunction with Gold Coast Open House.
- Gold Coast Open House is an annual City of Gold Coast cultural event that raises awareness of good architecture, design and the importance of preserving the city's historical and architectural assets.
- The event is made possible by founding partners the National Trust of Australia (Queensland), Australian Institute of Architects and City of Gold Coast.
- Gold Coast Open House has for the first time granted a video bursary to four emerging Gold Coast or Northern Rivers architects in 2020.
